Production and marketing of forest reproductive material

European Parliament legislative resolution of 19 May 2026 on the Council position at first reading with a view to the adoption of a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the production and marketing of forest reproductive material, amending Regulations (EU) 2016/2031 and (EU) 2017/625 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Council Directive 1999/105/EC (FRM Regulation) (17102/1/2025 - C10-0103/2026 - 2023/0228(COD))

(Ordinary legislative procedure: second reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council position at first reading (17102/1/2025 - C10-0103/2026),
- having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee of 13 December 2023¹,
- having regard to its position at first reading² on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2023)0415),
- having regard to Article 294(7) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
- having regard to the provisional agreement approved by the committee responsible under Rule 75(4) of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to Rule 68 of its Rules of Procedure,

- having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development (A10-0136/2026),
- 1. Approves the Council position at first reading;
- 2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the Council position;
- 3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council, in accordance with Article 297(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;
- 4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to arrange for its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*;
- 5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
